One





Command Central: Streamlining Patient Throughput

Nursing leaders at Hackensack University Medical Center have created the network's first Capacity Command Center to coordinate all aspects of patient throughput from admission to discharge.

"The idea for a Command Center, while not new to industries such as aviation and military, is more unique in health care," says Dionne Dixon, Ph.D., SSBB, BCBA-C, administrative director for Patient Care Operations, Logistics and Organizational Excellence at Hackensack University Medical Center.

The idea arose due to a lack of care coordination, a need to reduce financial losses associated with unnecessary delays in discharge and a desire to optimize organizational throughput performance, such as wait time, length of stay, discharge time, team communication and overall satisfaction.

To streamline coordination of many operational areas, the nurse-led project team created a central work area by reorganizing existing work space to include key capacity management roles. "We used no capital to achieve this," Dionne says. "We just used a Lean Six Sigma approach to reengineer existing resources and processes, and tremendous teamwork made it possible." Since it went live in May 2018, the Command Center has grown. "We have added our transfer center, Caregiver Hotline, telemetry monitor and admission-discharge-transfer RN process to the Command Center," Dionne says. "A call comes through the Command Center and all these things can be deployed."

Hackensack University Medical Center has already demonstrated the significant value of this initiative:

- Patient flow has improved (not accounting for seasonal differences).
- The median time from admit decision to Emergency Department (ED) departure decreased by 78 minutes.
- Average time from bed assignment to ED departure dropped by 46 minutes.
- ▶ Daily discharges at/before 11 a.m. increased.

"As a result of the Command Center, we recently had three consecutive days of no patients waiting in the ED, which has never happened. We also saw five consecutive weekends of no patients waiting in the ED," Dionne says. "We have definitely improved operational efficiency, and we look forward to a lot more improvements."

In January 2018, Mildred (Micki) Patrick, MSN, RN, NEA-BC, joined Southern Ocean Medical Center as the vice president of nursing and chief nurse executive.

With 30 years of nursing experience in various roles at Raritan Bay Medical Center in Perth Amboy and Old Bridge, she established an award-winning culture of excellence by raising health care quality standards through nursing operations and strategic planning. Most recently, she served as the assistant vice president of Nursing Quality, Practice, Professional

Development, Surgical Services and Maternal Child Health at Raritan Bay. Prior to that position, she was interim chief nurse executive at Raritan Bay and served as executive nursing leader for a 501-bed, two-

a 501-bed, twocampus acute care hospital. In this role, she directed nursing operations, nursing strategic planning and staff effectiveness, and guided Raritan Bay to its third Magnet designation on both campuses. She also played an integral role in coordinating a \$500,000 capital expenditure campaign and human resource structure in two campus surgical services to improve workflow and increase efficiency.

Dedicated to nursing excellence, Micki worked to decrease in-field door-to-balloon (DTB) times to an average of 63 minutes, which earned the hospital Silver Status in 2015 and Gold Status in 2017 from the American Heart Association. She introduced and led system-wide change to the nursing peer feedback process and managed the robotics surgery program launch at Raritan Bay in May 2017.



Seamless Care in the Face of a Fire and Flood

In early 2018, a small, quickly contained fire broke out in the break room of Bayshore Medical Center's Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Although the sprinkler system was effective in minimizing fire damage, there was significant water damage to the ICU, 2 North and 3 North.

During this incident, physicians, nurses, first responders and many other team members came together swiftly to safeguard Bayshore's patients, demonstrating the effectiveness of established

systems and protocols. The ICU, 2 North and 3 North were immediately evacuated to other areas of the hospital. Seventeen patients were transferred to other Hackensack Meridian *Health* hospitals, proving how valuable our integration is to providing safe and seamless care.

Due to significant water damage, all three units were temporarily closed while repairs were made. The impact of closing the units took 62 beds, 12 of which were private medical surgical rooms, out of service, resulting in a decrease in average patient daily census (ADC) from 140+ to 90. In turn, staffing levels needed to be adjusted for nurses, PCTs and unit secretaries/monitor techs. The reduction in ADC affected overall hospital operations and staffing.

After assessment, the team determined alternate locations for patient placement and new staffing models that accounted for increased volume and acuity in specific areas. Team members

Patty Kampf, BSN, RN, CRNI, assistant nurse manager of the Vascular Access Team at JFK Medical Center, has been instrumental in making improvements in the hospital's CLABSI rates since becoming chair of the CLABSI Committee in 2012. She incorporated Infusion Nurses Society (INS) standards and evidence-based practices in policies and procedures to improve patient outcomes. It was at that time that she had the Vascular Access Team start daily surveillance of all lines.

In addition to her outstanding accomplishments at JFK,



from affected units were reassigned to fill these additional needs. Chief nurse executives from other Hackensack Meridian *Health* locations also identified vacancies for temporary assignment of Bayshore team members impacted by the fire and flood.

Sixteen nurses accepted assignments at other Hackensack Meridian *Health* locations, while others took full paid time off, partial paid time off or remained at Bayshore—filling vacant positions on unaffected patient care units.

In just three short months, the ICU reopened with renovations designed for patients, physicians and team members, choosing eco-friendly materials wherever possible to support Bayshore's sustainability efforts. The collaboration and around-the-clock work of the entire team made the challenge of displaced patients and staff seamless, so that the impacted floors could be reopened as quickly as possible for the community.

Patty served as president of the New Jersey INS from 2013–2015 and presidential advisor of the New Jersey Infusion Society 2015–present. She has presented numerous educational programs and received numerous awards including the Gardner Foundation, Presidential Leadership Award, Infusion Nurses Society 2014, EPoster Presenter, CLABSI 2014, PI Finalist— Persistently Improving Central Line Care 2017 and INS Member of the Year, May 2018. She is also presently a contributing editor for the *Journal of Infusion Nurses*.

Patty is highly respected by her peers and leadership, and is often relied on for expert guidance. She understands the challenges and value of frontline staff, and utilizes their feedback to implement best practices on care of central lines.

Reengaging Preceptors with a Jolt of Appreciation



additional expense for recruitment and orientation. So it is important that stressors relating to precepting are acknowledged and strategies be employed to reduce stress.

A successful strategy for preventing preceptor burnout ensures that the preceptors are fully vested in the onboarding process. Previous research identified the following strategies as effective in engaging the preceptors:

Provision of a preceptor training program and continuing educational program with contact hour(s) awarded that discuss the goals of the preceptorship program, role of preceptors, different learning

An invaluable role, nursing preceptorship facilitates the nurse's transition into a highly technical, rapidly changing health care environment. Preceptors support the integration of newly employed nurses into the organization, which experiences constant change in response to medical advances and cost constraints. They also help new nurses familiarize themselves with their responsibilities in the work setting, unit norm and social culture. All of these contribute to the successful onboarding and safe development of a practicing nurse.

But being a preceptor is often perceived as stressful. Balancing their primary role as a patient caregiver while dedicating time to effectively teach a new hire is very challenging. They need to be a clinician, teacher, mentor and friend at the same time. Preceptors have described the experience as exhausting, and the stress and responsibility at times can be overwhelming.

The lack of engagement and preceptor burnout affects a nurse's retention and turnover. A high attrition rate creates


styles and adult education principles; provide effective and constructive feedback; and promote critical thinking and strategies that deal with skill-deficient preceptees.

Special recognition or award for serving as a preceptor from management, such as advancing to a higher level, receiving shift differential or bonus, a special group lunch or dinner and a certificate or letter of recommendation.

Hackensack Meridian *Health* already offers a preceptor training program. These mentors also get contact hour credit for precepting, and they are given a letter to signify that they precepted, which they use to advance their level in the clinical ladder program. An hourly pay differential is also given to preceptors on days they complete this task. But even with these strategies in place, we continue to have challenges in keeping our preceptors.

With this in mind, we developed a **Preceptor Appreciation Program** employing innovative ways of incorporating

meaningful rewards. A total of 78 preceptors were invited to attend the program, with 64 preceptors attending. The one-day program included the following:

- A discussion and review of the preceptor's role with emphasis on their role in successful onboarding and retention, adult learning and learning styles, and provision of effective feedback.
- An interactive activity where each preceptor shared their rewarding and challenging experiences, and how they deal with challenges they encounter.
- ► A self-care session discussing coping strategies like activity, rest and sleep, adequate nutrition, breathing exercises and meditation.
- A recognition program where each preceptor is awarded by their nurse manager, nurse educator and the chief nurse with a certificate, pin and white rose. Individual and group pictures were taken and featured in the leadership weekly update and nursing newsletter.
- An appreciation video featuring a short interview of the different preceptors while they enjoyed a sumptuous lunch.

The program was very well received. One of the attending preceptors wrote, "Thank you for offering this program. It inspired me to precept again and help in training our new nurses."

Added another, "Great program. It reinforced my commitment to ensure that our new nurses will have the knowledge and skills to practice safely."

Through this project we conclude the following:

- Preceptors are key in successful onboarding, training and retention of new hire nurses.
- The lack of engagement and preceptor burnout affects nurses' retention and turnover.
- Innovative strategies to reward and recognize will keep preceptors engaged. This will in turn ensure that the preceptors will be fully vested in the onboarding process.
- Successful onboarding will reduce turnover rates and promote the development of safe clinical practices.
- Reduced turnover prevents additional organizational expense on recruitment and orientation.

Initiating the Nursing Morbidity and Mortality Forum

In June 2017, the nursing leadership team at Ocean Medical Center reviewed the results of the Oro 2.0 tool, a nationally recognized way to assess an organization's progress in their high-reliability journey and to provide insight into some of the framework and characteristics needed to maintain a Highly Reliable Organization (HRO). The tool is produced by the Joint Commission Center for Care Transformation Division. One significant opportunity to facilitate our advancement in high reliability was the need to share lessons learned from our safety events.

Our mission at Hackensack Meridian *Health* is to transform health care and to be a leader in positive change. As part of a high-reliability action plan, the Nursing Morbidity and Mortality forum was developed and implemented at Ocean Medical Center to provide nurses an opportunity to share the lessons they've learned, in turn supporting the mission statement in transforming care and serving as a positive change.

Evidence from organizations such as the Institute for Healthcare Improvement, the Joint Commission and the National Quality Forum were reviewed and helped the team develop the infrastructure and guiding principles to support the nurse. Ocean Medical Center has created an environment, consistent with our mission statement, in which trust and rapport set the stage for learning via actual case reviews and courageous discussions.

The hospital's first Nursing Morbidity and Mortality case was presented in August 2017, and we have consistently held forums since then. We have found there is nothing more powerful than learning directly from the nurses, ranging from novices to highly seasoned professionals.

The value in analyzing the safety event cases has led to nursing practice changes. An example is the new IPASS tool that is completed by the inpatient and perioperative nursing staff to improve handoff communication. In addition, the peer support that is provided and gained throughout this experience has led to supporting a culture of reporting and trust.

Center for Simulation and Experiential Learning

In the 6,500-plus-square-foot, state-of-the-art simulation laboratory, interdisciplinary teams learn in a team-based environment. Medical residents gain training for various high-risk scenarios, allowing for real-time exposure to high-acuity incidents in a controlled environment. Nurses and allied health professionals also partake in scenarios. The integration of simulation-based and experiential learning into interdisciplinary education programs builds upon Hackensack Meridian *Health's* continued commitment to leadership in health care education.

Overall, the high-tech simulation laboratory fosters experiential and simulation-based learning with an emphasis on patient safety, quality, innovation and patient interaction. The Launch of a Nursing Workforce Environmental Staffing Committee



Nurses at Jersey Shore University Medical Center have been hard at work organizing their own Nursing Workforce Environmental Staffing Committee (NWESC). The journey to the committee's formation began when Donna Ciufo, DNP, MBA, RN, FNP-BC, CCRN, learned about the 2018 research from the Organization of Nurse Leaders/New Jersey (ONL/NJ).

Based on the American Academy of Critical-care Nurses' (AACN) healthy work environment standards, the research explored the nursing workforce environment and staffing of New Jersey nurses. Using the results of this research, ONL/ NJ created an extensive education program and framework for the Nursing Workforce Environment Staffing Committee.

Donna learned about the research during a presentation at the quarterly Nurse Executive Consortium meeting at the New Jersey Hospital Association (NJHA). When she heard about the opportunity to be a part of the next education cohort, she was sure Jersey Shore University Medical Center nurses would benefit greatly from participating.

Cohort 2B began in December 2018. Donna invited 18 frontline nurses and nurse leaders to participate in this group. The education consisted of three full-day education sessions held at NJHA. Donna and two other New Jersey Certified Nurse Educators (CNEs) were responsible for presenting the educational materials and leading the sessions.

After the first educational session, the Jersey

Shore University Medical Center team was excited to begin their very own NWESC. Invitations to join this committee have been extended to nurses in all areas of the hospital. The committee meets monthly, co-chaired by Donna; Patricia Mezzina, MSN (nurse manager NWP6); and Melissa Greenfeder, RN (frontline nurse NWP6).

Donna invited 18 frontline nurses and nurse leaders to participate in this group. The education consisted of three full-day education sessions held at NJHA.

As a group, the committee created a charter and work plan, and decided to first focus on the AACN standard of meaningful recognition. They are currently working on ways to standardize recognition on our units for the nursing team, highlighting degrees and certifications.

Dr. Susan H. Weaver Leads Research on the Administrative Supervisor

Administrative supervisors—the nurse leaders during the evening, night and weekend shifts enable hospitals to function 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, delivering safe, quality patient care. Although this role originated in hospitals more than 100 years ago, research on the value of these leaders is just beginning.

Susan H. Weaver, Ph.D., RN, CRNI, NEA-BC, a nurse scientist at Hackensack Meridian *Health's* Ann May Center for Nursing, started the research on this role with a nationwide qualitative study. Seven focus groups with night shift nurses were held, and 30 administrative supervisors from 20 states were interviewed to identify the supervisor's responsibilities and managerial practices that contribute to nurse and patient safety. Susan received funding for this research from the American

> Organization of Nurse Executives Foundation for Nursing Leadership and Education.

The study findings concluded that the supervisors do whatever is necessary to ensure the safety of patients, other team members and the hospital during the shift. Findings also indicated that supervisors acknowledged they lacked role-specific education, and additional research was needed.

Because of these findings, the Ann May Center for Nursing at Hackensack Meridian *Health* has held a statewide Administrative Supervisor Conference every year since 2017, covering topics like the impaired nurse, the incident commander role, authentic leadership, and supervisors' real-life experience evacuating a hospital and working the evening of a nightclub shooting. In 2017, administrative supervisors from 26 hospitals attended the conference and also participated in a research study about their leadership style and job satisfaction.

In 2018, administrative supervisors from 44 hospitals in the tri-state area attended and completed surveys about their job stressors, work engagement, job satisfaction and intent to leave. The 2019 conference will feature presentations on nursing leadership, hospital safety and security, and the real-life experience dealing with a hospital shooting, fire and flood. Supervisors who attend the 2019 Administrative Supervisor Conference will be invited to participate in a research study on the administrative supervisor practice environment.

In 2017, Dr. Weaver received a funding award from the Council on Graduate Education for Administration in Nursing (CGEAN) for the research and development of the Administrative Supervisor Practice Environment Scale.

This research is currently underway, and supervisors from throughout the country are participating. Information about these administrative supervisor research studies have been published in the following peer-reviewed journals: *Journal of Nursing Management, Nursing Administration Quarterly, Nursing Economic\$, Nurse Leader* and *Nursing Management*.

Seven focus groups with night shift nurses were held at the 2018 Administrative Supervisor Conference, and 30 administrative supervisors from 20 states were interviewed to identify the supervisor's responsibilities and managerial practices that contribute to nurse and patient safety.




